# **BDCA POLICY No.A-5**

## Jack Birkenshaw Award Criteria

### Purpose

This policy outlines the criteria in which the BDCA Executive Committee selects the Jack Birkenshaw Award for the promising junior in senior cricket within the BDCA.

### <u>Scope</u>

The BDCA Executive Committee is to use this policy to determine if the persons nominated meet the criteria outlined to receive the Jack Birkenshaw Award

#### **Procedures**

- 1. Nominees are provided to the Secretary by the Records Officer with all statistical information on the performance for 1<sup>st</sup> year players in senior 1<sup>st</sup> Grade cricket.
- 2. The Secretary must promptly present the information to the Executive Committee.
- 3. The BDCA Executive Committee must consider the nomination against the Jack Birkenshaw Award criteria.

#### Criteria for the Jack Birkenshaw Award

- 1. The nominees are a young player in their first year of senior cricket.
- 2. The nominees must have played in senior cricket with BDCA competitions. Or represented the BDCA in Association matches.
- 3. The nominees must have played an minimum of 10 senior cricket games
- 4. The nominees are to come from players who have played predominately 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Cricket.
- 5. A person can only be presented with this award once.
- 6. Statistics and Umpire votes determine a significant amount of credos for the nominees.
- 7. Performance of the person if they have represented the association is also a significant factor.
- 8. The attitude and behaviour are also significant factors to be considered.
