



BDCA POLICY No.A-4

Appointments of BDCA Patrons

Purpose

This policy is to outline procedures and criteria for prospective persons to assume the role as a patron of the BDCA.

Scope

The BDCA Executive Committee is to examine potential candidates that meet the criteria outlined in this policy.

Criteria

1. Is a person who has an association with the sport of cricket
2. Is a person who will lend credibility to the status of the BDCA with the community?
3. Is a person who can raise the profile of the game of cricket and that of the BDCA?
4. Is a person who has a link to the BDCA

Duties

1. Publically Assume a figurehead role within the BDCA
2. Attend functions the BDCA Committee sees appropriate for the person to attend.

Procedures

1. Executive Committee to draw up a list of prospective candidates
2. Examine each candidate with criteria.
3. Write a letter to the candidate/s that the Executive Committee has decided to approach for the role.
4. Upon acceptance of the role the patron is to be announced within the BDCA media.
